

PRELIMINARY TESTS AND PREPARING FOR A CT SCAN WITH CONTRAST MEDIUM

In order to undergo a procedure with contrast medium it is essential to perform the following preliminary tests:

- BUN
- Creatinine test
- Electrophoretic protidogram (with chart)
- Electrocardiogram (ECG)

These tests are only valid if performed within 30 days before the examination.

When booking your test remember to notify any acute/chronic diseases, allergy or bronchial asthma.

The day of the test you will be required to:

- bring the necessary preliminary tests
- bring any previous exams related to the CT scan you are to perform (ultrasounds, MRI, CT scans, X-rays, medical records)
- absolute fast in the 4 hours before the test
